Day of Competition

- First tee time: **7:00am.** Please arrive and check-in no sooner than 1 hour prior to your starting time.
- The driving range will open at 6:30am. Range balls will be provided.
- All players *must walk* for the qualifier.
- Caddies may use a golf cart for \$25+tax. Maximum of 3 carts per group.
- The snack shop will open at 10:00am
- The supplementary *Notice to Players* and chart of *Hole Locations* will be offered to you at registration.
- In the event of a tie for the qualifier(s) place or alternates place, there will immediately be a hole-by-hole playoff as determined by the Committee. Please plan your travel arrangements accordingly.

Reminders

- Distance Measuring Devices: *ALLOWED NO SLOPE*
- All players' clubs must conform to the groove and punch mark specifications in the Rules of Golf that are effective from January 1, 2010.

- Spectators: Not Allowed
- Dress Code: Collared shirts and appropriate golf shorts, pants, or skorts. Non-metallic spike only.
