Entry Fee: Military: \$150.00 Civilian: \$185.00
Includes 1 practice round and 2 tournament rounds with cart.

Format: 36 Hole Stroke Play

Eligibility: Female amateurs with a computerized GHIN handicap index as of February 1, 2018. GHIN card or GHIN# must be included with application. Entrants must be at least 15 years of age as of March 26, 2018.

Flights: Flights to be determined after sign up

Entry Rules: Players whose entries are accepted will be notified. All entries are subject to approval by the tournament committee. Contestants may be assigned to different flights if scores reflect inaccurate handicaps before or during the tournament. No refunds will be issued after March 23, 2018. U.S. Army golf courses require the use of soft spikes only, no metal spikes allowed.

Additional Information:

1. Trophies awarded to overall winner, and 1st and 2nd place in each flight. Gift certificates to half the field.
2. Practice rounds - Entrants have one free practice round but may schedule more than one. Monday, March 12 through Friday, March 23 (excluding weekends). For starting times call: Leilehua Golf Course 655-4653. (Make tee times one week prior).
3. Lunch will be provided on Monday and an awards banquet following Tuesday's round to all contestants.
4. The use of distance measuring range finders will be allowed.
5. USGA rules govern all play, except as modified by Local Rules.

A Brief History *(From a publication of the HJGA)*

The late Edna Jackola virtually "owned" the Army Women's Invitational at the height of her competitive career—winning eight championships between 1960 and 1969.

Martha Young won the maiden tournament in 1957, then it was Army nurse Amie Amizich in 1958 and 1959 before Jackola took the next three. No tournaments were held in 1963 and 1978. Jackola prevailed again in 1965, 1967 and 1968.

Lenore Muraoka, competing out of the University of Hawaii, plucked the first of her four Army Women's Invitational titles in 1975 by edging Tura Nagatoshi after tying at 156. She followed with 78-76-154 in 1976, shot 78-72-150 in 1977, and 77-76-153 in 1979.

Lynne Winn chalked up three straight championships, 1980-82 to join Jackola, Muraoka and Amizich as multiple winners of the Army Women's Invitational. Joan Damon, in 1971; Beverly Kong, 1972; Marlene Floyd, 1973; and Marga Stubblefield, 1975 also left their marks on the winners' roll.
