- Caddies may use a golf cart for \$32. Paid directly to Leilehua Golf Course.
- The supplementary *Notice to Players* and chart of *Hole Locations* will be offered to you at check in.
- In the event of a tie for the qualifier(s) place or alternates place, there will immediately be a hole-by-hole playoff as determined by the Committee. Please plan your travel arrangements accordingly.

- Distance Measuring Devices: *ALLOWED NO SLOPE*
- All players' clubs must conform to the groove and punch mark specifications in the Rules of Golf that are effective from January 1, 2010.
- Spectators: Allowed, \$20 walking or riding
- Dress Code: Collared shirts and appropriate golf shorts, pants, or skorts. Non-metallic spike only.
