- The Driving Range will open at 6:00am. Range balls will be provided.
- The restaurant will be open 11:00am-6:00pm.
- All players ***must walk*** for the qualifier.
- Caddies may use a golf cart for \$20 + tax (for 36-holes). Limit 3 carts per group
- The supplementary *Notice to Players* and chart of *Hole Locations* will be offered to you at registration.
- In the event of a tie for the qualifier(s) place or alternates place, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff immediately after the final group has finished.
- Spectators: ***Not Allowed***

Reminders

- Distance Measuring Devices: Allowed (slope measuring and club suggestion must be turned off)
- All players' clubs must conform to the groove and punch mark specifications in the Rules of Golf that are effective from January 1, 2010.
- Dress Code: Collared shirts and appropriate golf shorts, pants, or skorts. Non-metallic spikes only.
