

HAWAII STATE WOMEN'S GOLF FOUNDATION



In 2002, a small group of Hawaii's avid women golfers lead by a tenacious retiring bank executive joined together to promote and grow the game of golf for local women and junior girls. Under the keen leadership of Lily Yao, the notoriety of Hawaii Golf Hall of Fame's Bev Kim and others, these women formed a 501c3 nonprofit organization, Hawaii State Women's Golf Foundation (HSWGF). They raised significant funds in a short period of time and began their mission by offering golf workshops, supported the previous women's golf association, and funded travel stipends to aspiring female golfers playing in USGA championships nationwide.

Since inception of the HSWGF, over \$170,000.00 has been granted to 188 women and junior girls to help offset travel expenses to USGA National Championships. In addition, over \$25,000.00 has been granted to the local women's golf association in support of Women's golf activities.
