The final Championship will be held on July 25-30, 2022 at Bandon Dunes in Bandon, OR. The course will be set up at approximately 7004 yards Par 72 (subject to change pending weather conditions).

- Rate: \$35 One practice round at specified rate is available.
- Practice round dates: 6/17/22.
- You may start reserving tee times 1 week in advance.

Day of Competition

- **First tee time:** approximately 12:10pm
- All players *must walk* for the qualifier.
- Caddies may use a golf cart compliments of Hualalai Golf Course
- The supplementary *Notice to Players* and chart of *Hole Locations* will be offered to you at registration.
- In the event of a tie for the qualifier(s) place or alternates place, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff immediately after the final group has posted scores. Please plan your travel arrangements accordingly.

Reminders

- Distance Measuring Devices: *ALLOWED NO SLOPE*
- All players' clubs must conform to the groove and punch mark specifications in the Rules of Golf that are effective from January 1, 2010.

- Spectators: Yes, walking only.
- Dress Code: Collared shirts and appropriate golf shorts or pants. Non-metallic spikes only
