

Day of Competition

- **First tee time:** 7:30am Please arrive and check in no sooner than 1 hour prior to your starting time.
- All players <u>must walk</u> for the qualifier, but caddies will be allowed to use a golf cart for \$25+tax. 1 cart per caddie will be permitted.
- The supplementary Notice to Players and hole location sheets will be offered to you at check in on the day of competition.
- In the event of a tie for the qualifier(s) place or an alternate's place, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff immediately after the final group has posted scores. Please plan your travel arrangements accordingly.

Reminders

- Distance measuring devices: ALLOWED- Be sure to turn off slope measuring
- All players' clubs must conform to the groove and punch mark specifications in the Rules of Golf that are effective from January 1, 2010.

- Dress Code: Collared Shirts and appropriate golf shorts or pants required. Non-metallic spikes only.
- Spectators: *NOT ALLOWED*
